- Searchable strains/lines database of in-house mouse models

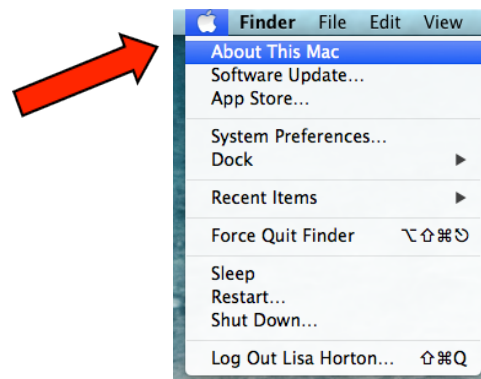

This is a subscription service with an annual licensing fee that includes version upgrades, secure backups and training.

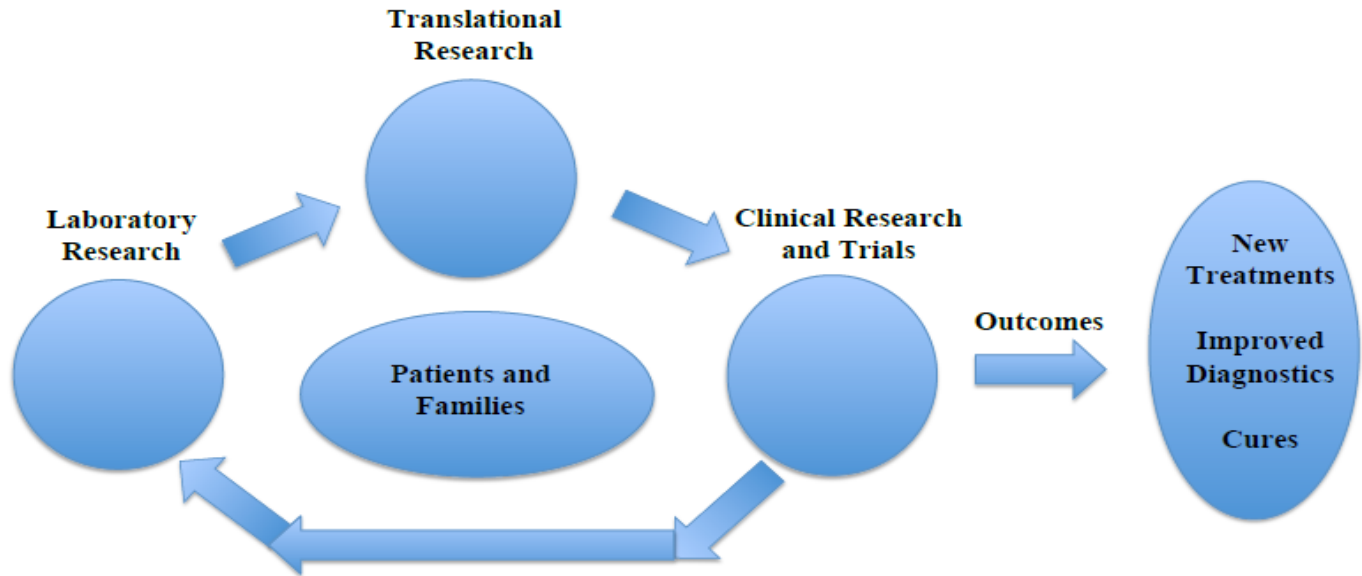

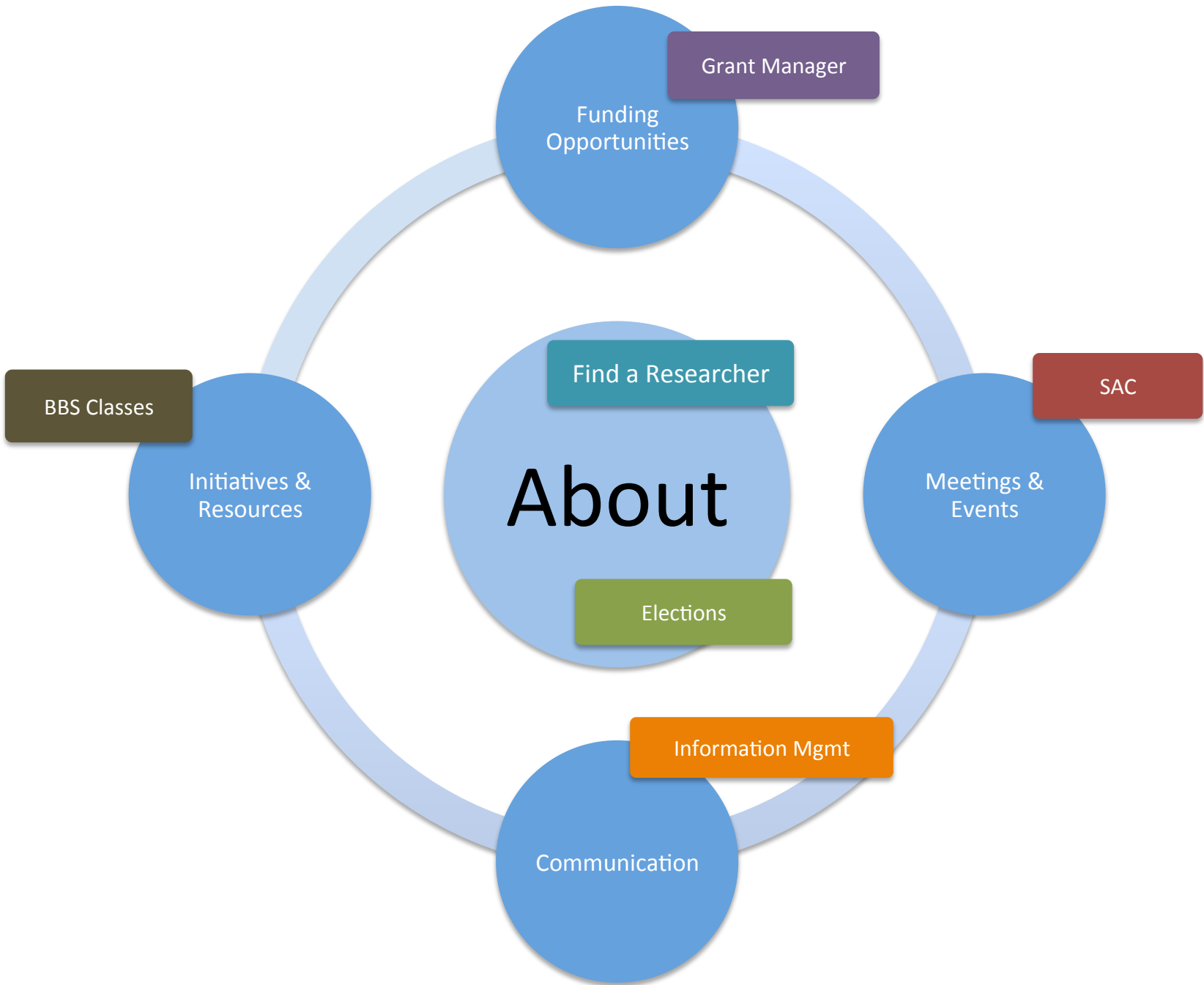
