What is QUOSA?

- QUOSA is desktop software that enhances PubMed and Ovid Medline searching and what you can do with the results.
- QUOSA helps you create your own fully searchable personal library (or shared library via Virtual Library) of PDFs, PPT slides and other files.

With QUOSA, you can...

- Download a lot of full-text articles in one step.
- Import and organize your PDFs and other files (images, charts, graphs, etc.).
- Search full-text of all your saved files.
- Set up alerts to saved searches.
- Share files with colleagues (QUOSA Virtual Library).

- Companion to QUOSA IM that enables sharing files lab/department-wide.
- Fully searchable database of articles shared between authorized users.
- User privileges to different libraries are customizable.
