MGH Youth Programs invites you to host a high school student this summer!

The Summer Jobs Program provides high school students who are rising 10th graders – 12th graders and recent high school graduates (Class of 2017) with an opportunity to work at MGH during the summer.



Quick Facts:

- The Summer Jobs Program will run 6 weeks from July 10-August 18
- Students/Interns work 25 hours per week Monday through Friday,
 No evenings or weekends!
- Students also participate in professional development workshops all trainings are coordinated by MGH Youth Programs



Roles of Department Hosts/Supervisors:

- Supervisors serve as mentors and coaches to the assigned student(s)
- They also ensure that students have opportunities to shadow and observe professionals in the department as appropriate.
- A Time Keeper must be provided upon registering as a host site interns will be using Kronos system.
- Supervisors need to monitor student hours to ensure accuracy of time reporting and that they are staying within 25 hours per week.
- Attend an orientation session in June (dates to be provided)
- Provide students with an orientation of the department, includes
 Providing them with instructions on Kronos/time reporting specific to
 department.
