Since the first prize was awarded in 1871, 26 of our awardees have gone on to receive the Nobel Prize.

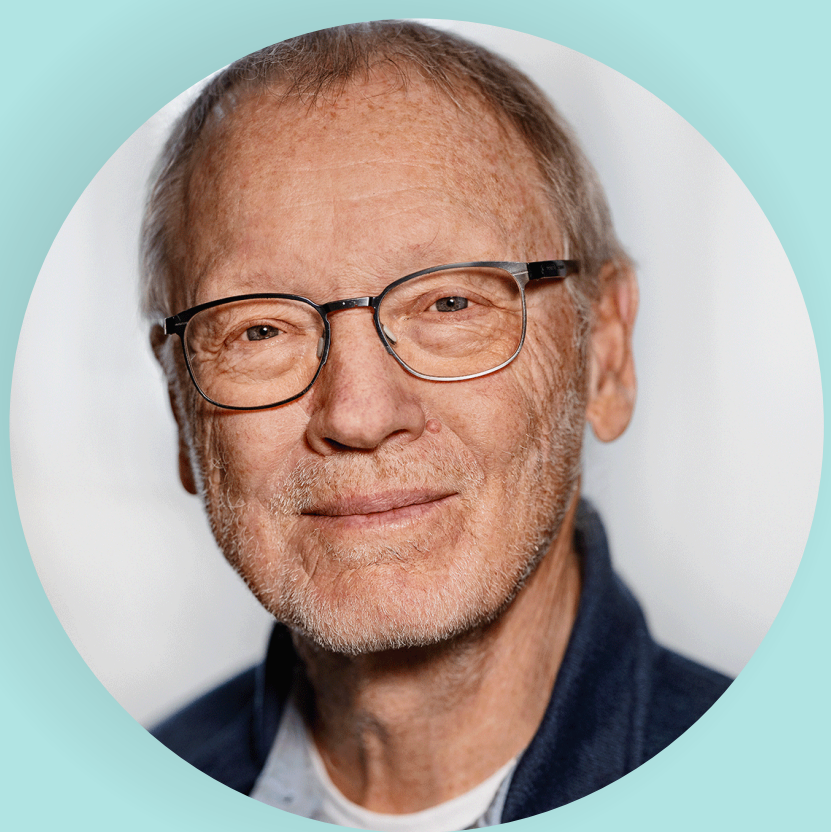
