Please be aware that any grant that brings in less than 15% in indirect costs (IDC) will need to be supplemented up to the 15% equivalent by existing investigator or departmental sundry funds. Resolution of this issue must occur prior to submitting a proposal. Training fellowships from foundations, public charity, and non-profit organizations are excluded from this minimum IDC requirement.

The MGB **Proposal Deadline Policy** establishes internal deadlines for sponsored research proposals to ensure that submissions meet sponsor criteria and institutional/regulatory requirements. Deadlines are:

- The complete Administrative Components are due to Research Management (RM) on or before the **8th Business Day** by 5 PM.
- *The Final (Science) Components are due to RM on or before the* **3rd Business Day**.

1. Sheila Essey Award: An Award for ALS Research, American Academy of Neurology (AAN)

This award recognizes an individual who has made significant research contributions in the search for the cause, prevention of, and cure for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS). The criteria being used to determine the recipient include recent major scientific impact, long-term scientific impact, and overall impact to ALS.

2. Afdhal/McHutchison LIFER Award, American Association for the Study of Liver Diseases (AASLD)

The purpose of this award is to foster career development for fellows performing clinical research and/or translational research in a liver-related area and who have shown commitment to excellence at an early stage of their research study. The award is intended to ensure that a significant portion of the investigators' time is protected for research, with an overall objective of enabling the investigators to develop independent and productive research careers in liver disease.

Eligibility requirements (partial list):

- The applicant must be postdoctoral or clinical research fellow who has completed their most recent doctoral degree or medical residency within the past five (5) years at the start of the grant term (July 1, 2022).
- The applicant must be a member of the American Association for the Study of Liver
 Diseases (AASLD) at the time of award application and maintain active membership for
 the duration of the award period.

3. Well-Being in FTD Pilot Grant, Association for Frontotemporal Degeneration (AFTD) COVID!

AFTD Pilot Grants provide seed funding for innovative, early-stage research projects with the potential to increase understanding and improve the diagnosis or treatment of frontotemporal degeneration (FTD) across the full spectrum of FTD disorders: behavioral variant FTD, primary progressive aphasia, progressive supranuclear palsy, corticobasal syndrome, and FTD-ALS. Pilot Grant-funded projects are intended to generate data that will support follow-on funding applications to the National Institutes of Health or other public or private agencies.

The Well-Being in FTD Pilot Grant supports projects that seek to develop non-pharmacological, evidence-based interventions for improving daily quality of life for people living with FTD and their families, mitigating caregiver burden, or advancing person-centered approaches to FTD care in out-of-home settings. Proposals that focus on strategies to support telemedicine or assist caregivers in meeting the unique challenges imposed by the emergence of COVID-19 are especially encouraged.

- New or early-stage investigators in the process of establishing an independent research
 program who have a faculty appointment or are serving a medical residency at an
 academic institution, teaching hospital, or other not-for-profit research institution
- Postdoctoral fellows cannot be Pilot Grant PIs, unless confirmation of a faculty appointment that will start within 3 months of the beginning of the funding period

4. Clinical Scientist Development Award (CSDA), Doris Duke Charitable Foundation (DDCF)

The Doris Duke Clinical Scientist Development Award provides grants to junior physician scientists to facilitate their transition to independent clinical research careers.

The transition to an independent research career is often more difficult for physician scientists than it is for other researchers, as these individuals must balance the demands of both seeing patients and conducting research. DDCF's Medical Research Program created the Clinical Scientist Development Award to provide mentored research funding to early-career physician-scientist faculty to enable their transition to independent and successful research careers.

Eligibility requirements (partial list):

- Have received an MD, DO or foreign equivalent degree from an accredited institution.
- Have a valid, active U.S. medical license at the time of application, though do not have to be U.S. citizens.
- Have a full-time faculty appointment as assistant professor at a U.S. academic institution that grants doctoral degrees. Adjunct, affiliated, temporary, part-time or acting faculty positions are not eligible for this competition. Applicants from **Harvard Medical School** should check our **FAQs** to determine eligibility of their faculty appointment.

5. Individual Investigator Research Award/Clinical Innovation Award, Foundation Fighting Blindness (FFB)

Individual Investigator Research Awards are designed to concentrate research in areas with the greatest potential to move toward treatments and cures for the inherited orphan retinal degenerative diseases and dry age-related macular degeneration.

The Foundation Fighting Blindness will also award up to three Clinical Innovation Awards that address: (1) developing and applying new technology to measure structure and function in inherited retinal degenerations; (2) establish relationships between measures of retinal functional and retinal structure with the goal of understanding the relationship between genotype and clinical phenotype; (3) identifying outcome measures or biomarkers to demonstrate change over a time period spanning no more than 2 to 3 years.

6. Diversity and Inclusion Health Equity Research Grant, Foundation for Women's Cancer (FWC)/Society of Gynecologic Oncology COVID!

Research among diverse populations has demonstrated disparities in treatment outcomes, access to care, genetic testing rates, and disease survival across many diseases.

The purpose of this award is to support research to understand and eliminate inequities in cancer care, specifically related to differential outcomes experienced by women from underserved or marginalized populations with gynecologic cancer, as well as to increase representation of underrepresented groups in gynecologic oncology as a strategy to achieve health equity for underserved women. Those eligible for applying are those who propose a study focused on a marginalized group, or those who identify as being from an underrepresented group within the field of research.

This year priority consideration will be given to proposals addressing health disparities in the context of gynecologic cancers related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Eligibility requirements (partial list):

- The applicant must be a member of the Society of Gynecologic Oncology, and their research must meet one of the following criteria:
 - the applicant must self-identify as being from a race, ethnicity, gender identity, or sexual orientation historically underrepresented in cancer research, or
 - their proposal must addresses gynecologic cancer topics including, but not limited to, access to care, therapeutic trials, and survivorship issues, among populations who are underserved or marginalized, based on their race, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation or socioeconomic status.

7. Grant for Infrastructure/Registry Research, Pediatric Epilepsy Research Foundation (PERF)

This competitive grant in child neurology is directed at developing new infrastructure, (registries and networks) or enhancing an existing infrastructure to enable advancement of patient based research. To that end, PERF offers the "PERF Grant for Infrastructure/Registry Research". We are interested in pediatric epilepsy and will also consider projects relevant to all areas of child neurology. Research projects providing opportunities for training and/or mentoring young investigators are of particular interest.

Eligibility requirements (partial list):

- To be eligible for this grant, the applicant should be a child neurologist at any stage in his or her career, or someone working in an area relevant to child neurology, either MD or PhD
- Non-child neurologists and PhDs developing infrastructure/registry projects in child neurology may also apply.

8. National Endowment for Plastic Surgery Grant, American Society of Plastic Surgeons (ASPS)/Plastic Surgery Foundation (PSF)

The National Endowment for Plastic Surgery Grant is intended to support research projects which translate clinical or basic science research findings into clinically relevant advancements or tools with a high likelihood of impacting daily practice and patient care within the next few years. Applications will be evaluated based upon the importance of the study question, soundness of study design, demonstration of study feasibility through preliminary/pilot data, the quality of the investigator team, and use of appropriate statistical and analytic methods.

Eligibility requirements (partial list):

- Applicants must hold a full-time clinical or research position.
- Be an Active, Candidate, International, or Associate member of ASPS or obtain sponsorship from an Active ASPS member at your institution (this is a requirement if you are currently in your training; for multiple PIs, a sponsor is required for only the applying PI; and ASPS Associate Members may apply with identified ASPS Sponsor).

9. PSF/MTF Allograft Tissue Research Grant, American Society of Plastic Surgeons (ASPS)/Plastic Surgery Foundation (PSF)

The PSF and MTF Biologics offer research grants to investigators studying allograft tissue transplantation in plastic and reconstructive surgery. These grants are intended to provide support for research projects focused on biologic repair and reconstruction with a strong clinical translation component that utilize dermal, adipose, placental or other allograft transplant technologies. Proposed studies should focus on novel translational and clinical research in the fields of tissue allograft transplantation and science, novel uses of allografts, combination with other biomaterials to enhance properties, and transformative regenerative medicine technologies relying on allograft tissues and matrices. However, proposals focusing solely on autologous grafts and synthetic applications that do not incorporate investigation of allograft use and/or grant proposals where the allograft is solely a scaffold for autograft materials (including cells) are beyond the scope of this award.

The PSF and MTF Biologics offer research grants for projects with a high likelihood of impact on scientific discipline and/or on patient care. Both clinical and basic science research projects will be considered for submission. Examples of clinical technologies of interest include but are not limited to the use of allograft biologics in breast reconstruction, wound healing, nose reshaping, soft tissue defect filling, allograft in fat transplantation and injection, use of allograft in tissue engineering or bioprinting, and other applications of allograft tissue in plastic and reconstructive surgery. Clinical evaluation of allograft tissues will also be considered for funding, following the same scientific topics and technologies previously described.

- Applicants must hold a full-time clinical or research position.
- Be an Active, Candidate, International, or Associate member of ASPS or obtain sponsorship from an Active ASPS member at your institution (this is a requirement if you are currently in your training; for multiple PIs, a sponsor is required for only the applying PI; and ASPS Associate Members may apply with identified ASPS Sponsor).

10. Research Fellowship, American Society of Plastic Surgeons (ASPS)/Plastic Surgery Foundation (PSF)

The PSF supports investigators from the beginning of their careers, during residency and as they advance to becoming experienced and well-established plastic surgeons. The purpose of the Research Fellowship Grant is to encourage research and academic career development in plastic surgery. This grant is for salary support only for a Resident or Fellow to obtain training and experience in research, under the guidance of an experienced mentor. The application must describe a structured research training plan, in addition to a research project. Only already funded research projects will be considered. Evaluation of the application will place emphasis on the research training experience, research project, applicant potential, and mentor qualifications and commitment to mentoring. Research Fellowship grants must be used for salary support only.

Eligibility requirements (partial list):

- Applicants must be a resident or fellow
- Obtain sponsorship from an Active ASPS member at their institution
- Devote 100% of their time to this research training for a continuous 12-month period and NOT be assigned to clinical rotations that satisfy residency requirements
